Entry Requirement - Academic

Completion of Year 12 is the required entry level for the childcare program. However, students who have completed Year 11 can be admitted if results are good.

English Language Proficiency

Minimum English proficiency level for entry to the childcare program (Certificate III) is 5.5 IELTS score or equivalent.

Age limit & WWCC - You should be over 18 years old when you start the course and clear with your Working With Children Check.

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL)

RPL is available if students have studied or worked in the childcare profession.

Intake Dates (4 intake dates per year)

- 2019: 4 Feb, 29 April, 22 July & 14 Oct
- 2020: 3 Feb, 27 April, 20 July & 12 Oct

Working Hours. Students are allowed for 40 hours paid-work per fortnight when studying. There is no working hour limit during term breaks.

Weekly timetables

We offer a blended timetable. You attend classes for 14 hours and complete another 6 hours (Structured self-study) doing required coursework (Certificate III) or doing work placement (Diploma). We monitor completion of your course work.

On top of this 20 hours per week you study in your own time then complete assessments.

Assessment - Every unit of competency has assessment tasks. You may have to spend up to 20 hours per unit, depending on the number of tasks and its level of difficulty



Childcare Practical Training Program (Non-accredited)

On completion of the Advanced Diploma of Leadership and Management, UPC offers you a 18-month Childcare Practical Training Program either utilising the Graduate Work Visa (Visa 485)⁽¹⁾ or Occupational Training (Visa 407)⁽²⁾. This opportunity will provide you to gain more experience for holding a senior childcare educator or managerial position.

To be eligible for visa sub-class 485, you have to apply while you are in Australia, within 6 months after completing your last related course and your English proficiency should be 6.0 IELTS. The important requirement for visa sub-class 407 is having a sponsor. You are eligible for both visas (Conditions apply) (3)

Quality childcare educators and managers are in high demand in many countries from Australia to Asia, Europe & North America. On completion of the program, you can


- enrol into a Bachelor degree (Up to 18 months of credit - Conditions apply);



This qualification provides graduates looking to work with children in a supervised or unsupervised capacity with an understanding of child-centred approaches, knowledge about learning and development, and using organisation policies, procedures and individual children's profiles to plan activities and provide care to children, facilitating their leisure and play and enabling the children to achieve their physical and mental development.

CHC50113 Diploma of Early Childhood Education & Care

CRICOS Code 083065G

On completion of the Certificate III, you continue to do the Diploma (18 months) which covers early childhood education, childcare and centre management. You will study childcare development, behaviour management, staff support, working with parents and the community and centre management.

If you enrol directly into the CHC50113, it will take you 24 months to complete the course.
