Objectives of the Internship Program

The two main objectives of our program are to let you

Features of the Internship Program

- Duration Six months (or two terms) during Terms 2 and 3 of your 4-term course
- Volume of practical training Up to 480 hours
- **Training plan** Your training plan is supervised by an appointed supervisor at your workplace and a qualified assessor from UPC. All activities will be recorded in a workplace logbook.
- **Recognition** Your internship training program is a component of your Diploma or Advanced Diploma qualification.
- **Extra recognition** On successful completion of the internship program, you will receive a reference letter from the host company and a certificate of work experience from Study and Work.
- Satisfaction Guaranteed If you are not given meaningful and relevant job duties, we will change your host company.
- **Chance of job offer** If you perform your duties satisfactorily, there is a high chance of job offer by the host company during or after you have completed the internship program.
- Job placement If you are eligible to work in Australia, S&W will assist you with employment after the program.

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What will my job duties be?

Depending on the host company's requirements, your main job duties could include assisting concerned managers with research, reporting, design and testing, analysis, project management, operational coordination, quality control, administrative duties, service delivery, etc. Your job duties will be negotiated and specified in the training plan.

Can I claim academic credits?

Yes, you can gain academic credits and you will be ensured on-the-job training compatible to your course objectives. The internship will not impact your 40-hour per fortnight work limitation on student visa as it is part of your course. Thus, you can still work part-time beyond internship for income.

How much do I have to pay for internship placement?

You have to pay a placement and supervision fee of \$2,000, which covers the costs of arranging your host company, internship agreement with a tailored training plan, insurance, performance appraisals and certificate of completion.

When can I start?

You can start the internship as soon as you start the course if you have already had a relevant qualification or at least 2 years of work experience in the field. Otherwise, you will start your internship from the third term. We recommend that you apply for enrolment at least one month before your intended start date. This enables us to find you the most suitable placement opportunity, organise interviews, confirm placement and develop a training plan with the host company.
