- Entry requirement: Completion of CHC30121
- Standard study duration: 24 months
- Number of units: 12 core & 3 elective units

- Study duration: 24 months [or 18 months for students holding the CHC33015 (Ageing) or CHC33021 (Ageing)]
- Number of units: 15 core & 2 elective units

##### CHC43121 Certificate IV in Disability Support

- Entry requirement: Completion of CHC33021 (Disability) or CHC33015 (Disability) or CHC30408 plus CHCSS00125
- Study duration: 18 months
- Number of units: 7 core & 3 elective units

**Training under the Smart & Skilled Program** (SSP) is subsidised by the NSW Government. The funding conditions are consistent, whether you study at NSW TAFE or a government approved provider like UPC College because the outcome qualifications are nationally recognised.



Trainees who enrol in a traineeship course before 30 June 2025 are eligible for fully subsidised tuition fees, in other words, fee-free.

#### Enrolment Conditions

You must satisfy the following conditions:

- living or working in NSW and
- an Australian or NZ citizen, an Australian permanent resident, a humanitarian visa holder or an asylum seeker ([25 temporary visa types](#) are now eligible) and
- starting employment within the first 3 months (full time) or 12 months (part time).

### Enrolment Procedure

- Contact UPC for a pre-enrolment assessment.
- A consultant from an Apprentice Connect Australia Provider will visit you at your workplace to assess your eligibility and help you to sign a Training Contract with your employer.
- A training plan will be worked out based on your commitment to the course.
- Commence the training with a UPC trainer.

### Other Courses Available at UPC

UPC offers additional fee-free courses to support you to successfully completed your training:

- **English Course:** You may attend our English classes in Sydney to improve your English proficiency before starting a government-funded course.
- **Pre-vocational or Part-qualification Programs:** Before committing to a specific course, you can explore it by participating in these programs.
